

Kūṭagārasutta¹ - Peaked House (SN 56:44)

1114. catutthe **heṭṭhimam gharam akaritvāti thambhabhittipādussāpanādinā gharassa heṭṭhimabhāgam akatvā.** Having not built the lower portion of the house in terms of erecting pillars, walls, foundation, etc....

akaritvā = akatvā (same root, dhātu samvaṇṇā).

sakatvā 1 abs. (+acc) having not done; having not performed [na > a + √kar + tvā].

heṭṭhimam gharam = thambhabhittipādussāpanādinā gharassa heṭṭhimabhāgam.

thambhabhittipādussāpanādinā = thambha, pillar + bhittipāda, wall-foundation + ussāpana + ādinā

ussāpana nt. lifting up, raising, erecting .
